

UNMASK EPILEPSY POSTER CONTEST GUIDELINES AND RULES

To Qualify for Entry:

- Original work
- Completed Entry Form
- Some purple color
- Appropriate subject matter (as outlined)
- No ineligible content (see below)

Originality:

Poster must be entirely original work.

Size:

Participants may create an entry on white, unlined surface. Any rectangular dimension, no larger than 16in x20in.

Medium:

Any fine art medium (paint, pens, markers, pencil, crayons etc.) no completely digital designs, some digital medium can be incorporated but only in part.

Subject matter:

- The official color of epilepsy awareness is purple, the design must include some purple in your design
- A phrase similar to “Epilepsy is NOT...” (see example posters) that nullifies some misconception/stigma/fear about epilepsy

Ineligible content:

- No lewd, obscene, explicit, disparaging, defamatory, libelous, or otherwise inappropriate content, or objectional material as determined by AKF in its sole discretion.
- No copyrighted or trademarked material that affects intellectual rights, and no commercial content, logos, or recognizable images that are not owned by the poster creator
- No easily identifiable personal material of any person other than the person or family
