Epilepsy Services Program

The program works to increase the independency of individuals with epilepsy, awareness of epilepsy, research about the condition, and understanding the neurological functions in individuals with epilepsy. By providing patient assistance and referrals, education, and prevention services, we strive to attain a positive effect in the care and treatment of individuals with epilepsy.

Services Include:

- Low or no cost medical care
- Epilepsy self-management and education support
- Screening and diagnostic testing
- Mental health support
- Assistance with vocational rehabilitation, housing, food, and medicines

Epilepsy Medication Assistance Program

Provides medication for eligible Florida residents. Contracted providers can assist individuals with the application process.

Eligibility and Registration

To register for program assistance, contact your county's contracted provider, listed on reverse side, and complete their registration process. Required eligibility information will include:

- Proof of permanent Florida residency, such as:
 - Florida driver's license or identification card
 - Current utility bill in the individual's name with a valid Florida address
 - Current Florida voter registration card
 - Current school record or registration certificate from a Florida k-12 school
- Diagnosis of epilepsy, have had a seizure or suspected seizure, and require services to diagnose epilepsy

Epilepsy medication assistance applicants must also:

- Have no insurance or other medical service coverage
- Have assets less than \$2,500 in private funds, bank accounts, or assets, other than a homestead

Contact your local provider to find out if you are eligible for help through the epilepsy programs.
